

SERIAL NUMBERS

Each JD450-B Tractor has two serial numbers: one for the basic tractor, and one for the engine.

The basic tractor serial number for tractors built prior to serial number 142200 is located on the front seat panel.

The basic tractor serial number for tractors built after serial number 142199 is located on the battery box front plate.

The engine serial number plate is located below and to the rear of the fuel pump mounting boss on the right side of the cylinder block.

Left hand side and right hand side, front and rear of the crawler are viewed by facing in the direction of crawler forward travel.

Whenever serial numbers are required on all warranty claims or correspondence pertaining to this product, it is extremely important that all twelve characters be furnished. This point cannot be overemphasized.

1. Digits 1 through 4 designate the tractor model.

450B - JD450-B

2. Digit 5 designates the tractor type, fuel, and transmission.

A - Loader

C - 6405 Dozer

D - 6410 Dozer

E - 6415 Dozer

J - Drawbar Tractor

3. Digits 6 through 11 designate the tractor serial number shown in the serial number column of this catalog.

4. Digits 12 and 13 designate the manufacturer of the tractor.

AN EXPLANATION OF SERIAL NUMBER INFORMATION

Serial number information is listed parenthetically to show on which machines each part can be used. These listings are explained by the following examples.

(-) The part can be used on all machines.

(000000-) The part can be used on all machines beginning with the serial number listed.

(-000000) The part can be used on all machines up to and including serial number listed.

(000000-000000) The part can be used on all machines between and including the serial numbers listed.

Where XXXXXX's are listed in place of a serial number it indicates a serial number change was made but the exact serial number had not been established when the catalog went to press.

AN EXPLANATION OF CHANGE INDICATOR LINE

New and revised information is identified by vertical lines marked in the left-hand margin of revised pages. These lines indicate changes affecting the ordering of parts.
